June 6 2019 Japheth Bible Reading & Meditation passage : Psalm 119:17-24

Beloved of God, take note of verse 18:

"Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of the law"

This is a prayer we need to pray daily before we read the word of God. This is because we need the illumination of the Holy Spirit to see the deep truths and wisdom hidden in the Bible. My personal experience is an example. Even though I made an "A" in a West Africa School Certificate Exam subject called "Bible Knowledge" back in 1979, I did not begin to understand the scriptures until 1989 when I had a personal encounter with Christ!

In 1979, the Bible was a mere story book or a textbook in the history of the Jews to me. But now, with the help of the Holy Ghost, it is a guide to everyday successful living in a difficult and ungodly world; a candle light in a dark alley; and a refreshing fountain of living water in the midst of a dry desert!

In summary, it is very essential we sincerely ask the Holy Ghost to help us understand the scriptures every time we set to gaze into this wonderful book of life. Of a truth, it contains wondrous things if our eyes are divinely opened. This experience is called "revelation".
