June 7 2019 Japheth Bible Reading & Meditation passage : Psalm 119:25-32

Beloved of God, take note of verse 30:

"I have chosen the way of truth: thy judgments have I laid before me"

This verse projects two important words that the Bible uses severally to describe the very nature of God. These are the words "truth" and "judgement". Judgement in this verse signifies "divine truth" and the intelligence that derives from that truth" The Psalmist is therefore saying that he has made a deliberate choice to live, in a world system built on falsehood, by the divine truth as revealed by the sacred word of God ! Not truths as projected by the world system through the print, electronic or social media, specialized text books, Nobel laureates, cultural and social norms and values, political and social ideologies, philosophies of men etc. These sources of truth are fallible and cannot be depended upon; but we can build our hopes of eternity safely on the divine truths (judgements) as revealed in the Holy Bible, if we take enough time to prayerfully explore its hidden treasures.
