"Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity: and quicken thou me in the way". Vanity refers to "emptiness". Riches are vain because we will leave it behind for those who did not labour for it to enjoy. Life on this side of eternity is also vain because no matter how great/powerful we become or how much we accomplish, we will end up 6 feet below the ground just like a man who lived all his life on the street! Pleasure is also vain because, when we grow old, most of the things we have great pleasure in will fade and our soul will no longer delight in them! Here is the problem, focusing our attention on the pursuit of riches, power and pleasure in this world can severely hinder our ability to focus on the things we must do to enter into the eternal bliss that the Lord has promised will come in the future. To pray this prayer everyday is to let God know that the coming kingdom of God is more important to us than the attractions of this present world, ruled in a large part by the powers of darkness. May the Lord be gracious unto us as to turn our eyes away from vanity and empower us to walk in His way. Amen.
